### About some of the terms we use in this document

There may be some terms we refer to in the document that you may not be familiar with. Here are the meanings of these terms.

Terminology	Description
Benefit year	A benefit year refers to the benefits a member is entitled to during a calendar year, that is to say 1 January to 31 December. This medicine list (formulary) is applicable for this benefit year only.
NAPPI Code	This is a unique identifier for a given medicine, surgical or consumable product.
